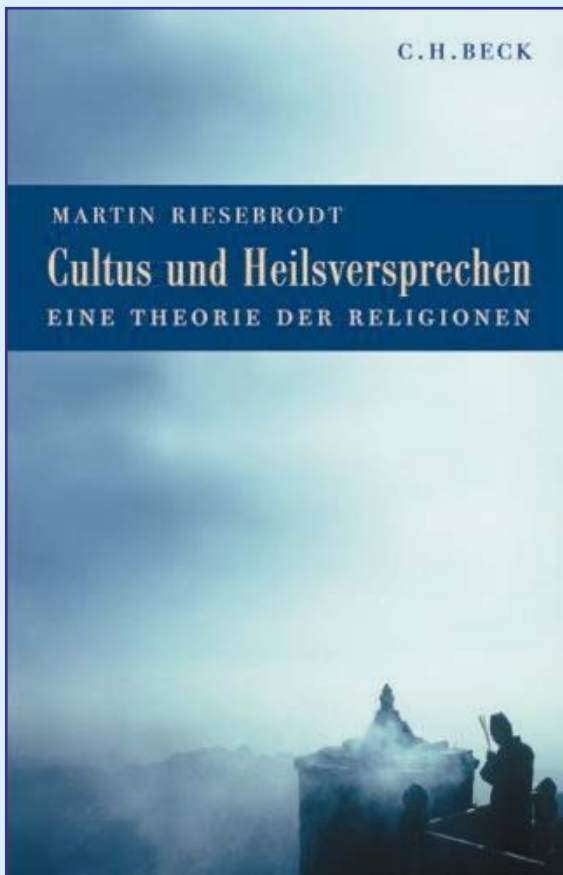

IN THE FIELD OF RELIGION, A NEW BOOK BY **MARTIN RIESEBRODT** IS AN IMPORTANT EVENT. Riesebrodt is one of the world's leading comparative analysts of religious fundamentalism based on his epochal book, *Pious Passion, The Emergence of Modern Fundamentalism in the United States and Iran*. This last year, his book theorizing religion, *Cult and the Promise of Salvation: A Theory of Religions*, was published in Germany by C.H. Beck. The University of Chicago Press is currently translating it for publication next year. This is your chance to hear about it before it hits the bookshelves in America.
